

Annual Political Expenditure Return

Completing this Return

- **Part 1** of this return must be completed by any person who incurred, by or with his or her own authority, political expenditure of more than:
 - o in the case of a *third party* \$10,000 (indexed); or
 - o in any other case \$5,000 (indexed),

during the last financial year (section 130ZR of the Electoral Act 1985 ('the Act')).

- Current indexed amounts can be found on the Electoral Commission SA's website.
- The Crown and members of the House of Assembly or Legislative Council do not need to complete this return.
- Part 2 of this return must be completed if:
 - a person is required to lodge an Annual Political Expenditure Return or Capped Expenditure Period Return; and
 - o at any time the person received any gifts of more than \$5,000 (indexed) that the person used during the financial year (either wholly or partly):
 - to incur political expenditure; or
 - as reimbursement for incurring political expenditure (section 130ZS of the Act).

Part 2 does not need to be completed by a relevant entity (registered political party, associated entity or third party), a candidate in an election, or a member of a group.

- Part 3 of this return only needs to be completed by a third party.
- A *third party* is defined in section 130A of the Act as a person who:
 - o incurs or intends to incur more than \$10,000 in political expenditure during the designated period of an election, or
 - o incurred more than \$10,000 in political expenditure during the designated period of the last preceding general election.

A third party **does not** include:

- o Members of the Parliament of South Australia;
- o the Crown;
- o a registered political party, candidate or group;
- a person engaged in a broadcasting service (within the meaning of the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992*) or a datacasting service; or
- the publisher of a journal.
- Lodged returns will be available for public inspection 3 business days after the due date.
- **Political expenditure** is defined in section 130A(1) of the Act and in regulation 26 of the *Electoral Regulations 2024*. For more information please contact the Compliance Branch.

For each gift over \$5,000 (indexed) the following details must be disclosed:

- name and address of the person or organisation who made the gift;
- date each gift was made; and
- value or amount of each gift.

In the case of a gift made:

- on behalf of the members of an unincorporated association, you must provide the following details:
 - (i) the name of the association; and
 - (ii) the names and addresses of the members of the executive committee (however described) of the association;
- out of a trust fund or out of the funds of a foundation, you must provide the following details:
 - (i) the names and addresses of the trustees of the fund or of the funds of the foundation; and
 - (ii) the title (or other description) of the trust fund or the name and address of the foundation, as the case requires.

For the purposes of completing this return, 2 or more gifts of more than \$200 made during the financial year, by the same person or organisation, are taken to be 1 gift.
