1. This nomination may be rejected if the name to appear on the ballot paper is considered to be obscene, frivolous or assumed for an ulterior purpose in accordance with section 54(2) of the *Electoral Act 1985*.
2. This form must be lodged by the registered officer of the party alongside completed form RO 40A at least 48 hours prior to the hour of nomination.
3. Candidates who have indicated their intention to lodge voting ticket(s) must ensure such ticket(s) are lodged within 72 hours from 12 noon on the day of the close of nominations.
4. How-to-vote cards for display in polling booths under section 66 of the *Electoral Act 1985* must be approved by the Electoral Commissioner and lodged with the Electoral Commission SA no later than 4 days after the day for nomination.
5. Nominations are accepted at face value. It is the responsibility of candidates to ensure they are qualified for election.
